

An act relating to the management and usage of the Prescott Tavern.

“Tavern Act”

BE IT ENACTED BY THE HAMPSHIRE STUDENT UNION TOWN MEETING

Section I: Intent

The Tavern is a critical student space that is managed by the Office of Campus Leadership and Activities, supervised by Associate Dean of Students for Campus Leadership and Activities, Pam Tinto. Many students consider the Tavern an underutilized space. Furthermore, many students have had difficulty gaining access to the space to run programs and events of their design. This act outlines a new management system for the Tavern that values community ownership and oversight from the administration of Hampshire College.

Section II: Definitions

Hampshire Student Union shall be referred to as the HSU.

Section III: Guidelines

(1) The Scope Group on Student Experience shall form a committee to review the current Tavern management practices and space usage. This committee, named the Tavern Committee, shall present a document to the HSU Town Meeting no later than April 2014 outlining the following:

- A. A new management scheme for the Tavern.
- B. A proposal to open the space twenty four hours a day. This proposal should include a feasibility study on the usage of Onecard locks.
- C. A plan for energizing the space.
- D. A proposed funding plan.

(2) The HSU shall request the Dean of Students to direct their staff to attend meetings of the before mentioned Tavern Committee.

Section IV: Nullification

All HSU document language in violation of this act is now null and void.

Section V: Effective Date

This act shall take effect on January 1 of 2014.
